

DOMESTIC ELECTRICAL DANGER NOTIFICATION

Issued by a Domestic Installer registered with NICEIC, Warwick House, Houghton Hall Park, Houghton Regis, Dunstable LU5 5ZX.

The competent person issuing this Notification will be able to provide further specific advice.

NOTES FOR RECIPIENTS

IF YOU ARE NOT A PERSON HAVING RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE SAFETY OF THE ELECTRICAL INSTALLATION OR EQUIPMENT CONCERNED, IT IS IMPORTANT THAT YOU PASS THIS NOTIFICATION TO SUCH A PERSON WITHOUT DELAY.

The Domestic Installer registered with NICEIC issuing this Notification has found that a part or parts of the electrical installation identified overleaf are in a potentially dangerous condition. The safety of those using the installation may be at risk.

Appropriate action needs to be taken immediately to remove the danger. The action taken (such as switching off and isolating the affected part(s) until remedied) should be recorded overleaf.

Urgent remedial work is necessary to bring the installation up to the standard required by the current issue of the national standard for the safety of electrical installations, British Standard 7671 - *Requirements for Electrical Installations*. The Domestic Installer registered with NICEIC issuing this Notification will be able to provide further advice.

This Notification is intended to be issued only for the purpose of reporting a dangerous condition in an existing electrical installation. The Notification records only damage, deterioration, defects, dangerous conditions and any non-compliances with the requirements of the national standard for the safety of electrical installations which give rise to real and immediate danger. It is not a detailed or comprehensive report on the condition of the installation or equipment concerned. A periodic inspection of the installation may be necessary to determine the full extent of any deficiencies.

Only a Domestic Installer registered with NICEIC is authorised to issue this Domestic Electrical Danger Notification. A person having responsibility for the safety of the electrical installation should have received the copy marked 'Original' and the Domestic Installer should have retained the report marked 'Duplicate'. The Notification has a printed seven-digit serial number which is traceable to the Domestic Installer to which it was supplied by NICEIC.

Should a person having responsibility for the safety of the electrical installation have reason to believe that the issue of this Notification is unjustified, they should in the first instance raise the specific concerns in writing with the Domestic Installer registered with NICEIC. If the concerns remain unresolved, they may make a formal complaint to NICEIC, for which purpose a standard complaint form may be downloaded from the NICEIC website (www.niceicgroup.com), or is available from NICEIC on request.
